

## What Do I Put In My Recycling Bin?



METAL CANS	Rinse metal cans and place in bin
ALUMINUM	Rinse aluminum drink cans and place in bin
GLASS	Rinsed, clear, green and brown glass bottles and jars. No mirrors, window glass, plate glass or light bulbs. Colored glass is accepted.
PLASTIC	Only plastic bottles with recycling symbols of #1, #2, #3, #4, #5 & #7 can be recycled. Examples of these bottles include milk jugs, soft drink liter bottles, cleaning bottles and shampoo bottles. Please rinse and remove lids/sprayers.
NEWSPAPER, MAGAZINES, CATALOGS, TELEPHONE BOOKS	Place magazines, catalogs and phone books in bottom of your bin. Include slick, glossy inserts with newspapers. <b>DO NOT PUT OUT ON A RAINY DAY.</b> Be sure that paper items are secured to keep from flying out of the bin.
JUNK MAIL, CARDBOARD And MIXED HOUSEHOLD PAPER	Place all junk mail, envelopes, cereal boxes, cardboard, chipboard and any other household paper products in a brown paper grocery bag and put inside your bin. These loose paper products need to be separate from other materials in your bin. <b>NO</b> tissues, wet paper or paper contaminated with food products are accepted. All cardboard must be broken down to a size that will fit inside the bin.
