



Don't pour the grease from your holiday meals down the drain. Recycle it instead during the [2014 Holiday Grease Roundup](http://www.ceasethegreasentx.com/), Dec. 6-13 <http://www.ceasethegreasentx.com/>.

Fort Worth collects grease and cooking oil year-round at the [Environmental Collection Center](#), 6400 Bridge St. The city will use your collected cooking oil and grease to create biodiesel or turn it into biogas for energy production.

Facts about grease:

- Grease hardens in pipes, causing major clogs and sewer overflows.
- If the sewer overflows, city crews have to shut down streets, tying up traffic and increasing expenses for you and the city.
- To dispose of grease, pour it into a covered container like an old coffee can. Recycle it at the Environmental Collection Center.
- Cooking oil should never be poured down the drain. If you deep-fry a turkey, put the used cooking oil into a rigid plastic container with a screw-top lid (maybe even the container the oil came in) and recycle it.
