4) REQUIREMENTS

- a) A permit(s) must be acquired prior to beginning work. Permits are available at, and must be returned to, the Community Development Dept., 3200 Diana Dr. Permit Fee is \$50.
- b) Permit(s) must be displayed on the job site
- c) City utilities must be exposed with a minimum of 2 ft. separation between the City of Richland Hills utility lines and all franchise utility lines.
- d) Street crossing must be bored by directional methods.
- e) Three (3) copies of construction plans must be submitted five (5) working days prior to beginning work.
- f) All underground utilities must be located and marked prior to beginning work. **Contact the Public Works Dept. for Water & Sewer line locates-817-616-3830.**
- g) Proof of insurance is attached or on file.
- h) The contractor shall contact the Community Development Department at least 48 hrs. in advance of the start of the project unless authorized by the City.
- i) Construction hours are Monday – Friday, 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m. No Saturday or Sunday work allowed without prior approval from the authorized agent of the City of Richland Hills.
- j) This permit becomes null and void if construction has not begun within 30 days.
- k) Above ground route/location markers are not permitted except as required by law.

Applicant shall indemnify and forever hold the City harmless against each and every claim, demand or cause of action that may be made or come against it by reason of or in any way arising out of the closing, blocking, excavating, cutting, tunneling, or other work by the applicant under permit from the City if such permit is granted, unless otherwise provided by law.
