

Acceptable Bulk Items

- Furniture
- Appliances (no Freon items without certification of removal)
- TVs
- Outdoor furniture & toys
- Small items, such as clothing, small appliances, etc., must be containerized
- Fence panels/posts
 - Must be cut to 4-foot lengths
- Tree limbs, tree trimmings and brush
 - Must be cut to 4-foot lengths
 - Must be bundled in manageable bundles weighing less than 50 pounds

Unacceptable Bulk Items

- Tires
- Construction materials, commercial waste and non-compactible items including, but not limited to:
 - Concrete
 - Rock
 - Tile
 - Bricks
 - Shingles
 - Toilets and bathtubs
 - Building materials
- Hazardous waste such as paints, fertilizers, pool chemicals and Freon
 - These items may be disposed of at the City's Household Hazardous Waste & Document Shredding event (richlandhills.com/HHW)
- Medications (richlandhills.com/SUDS)
- Large, uncut trees
- Unbagged or containerized items such as debris, paper, clothing or general household trash put out on your regular service day
